

# **Psalms for every Season**

## ***“Seasons of Sin and Repentance”***

As we continue our series on **Psalms for every Season**, this morning we’re going to consider Psalm 32, the *after effects* of David’s sin with Bathsheba. I’ve entitled this lesson, ***“Seasons of Sin and Repentance”***.

### **The Joy of Being Right with God**

- Blessed is he whose transgressions are forgiven – Psalm 32:1
- Whose sin the Lord does not count against him – Psalm 32:2

### **The Burden of Sin and Guilt**

- Sin destroys our lives! – Psalm 32:3; Isaiah 59:1-2
- Guilt weighs us down and robs us of our joy – Psalm 32:4

### **The Forgiveness of Sin and Removal of Guilt**

- We must **admit** our guilt – Psalm 32:5a; Psalm 51:3-4, 16-17
- We must **confess** our sins – 32:2, 5b; Psalm 51:4
- We must **pray** for forgiveness – Psalm 32:6; Psalm 51:1-9

### **The Blessed Life of the Forgiven**

- God will direct our lives and watch over us – Psalm 32:8-10
- God will fill our lives with joy and gladness! – Psalm 32:11
