Romans 6:3-14; I Corinthians 11:23-26

It has always been man’s tradition to celebrate and memorialize people and events worthy of great recognition. For Christians, **Easter** marks the most significant event in all history – **The Resurrection of Jesus**. To us it’s much more than just a yearly holiday – it’s a daily celebration! BAPTISM

- It *symbolizes* the death, burial and Resurrection of Jesus – Romans 6:3-4
- It’s where *we receive the benefits* of His sacrifice – Acts 2:38
- It’s a *lasting memorial of our union* with Jesus – Romans 6:5-14

THE LORD’S SUPPER

- It’s a time to *remember our Lord* – Luke 22:19-20; 1 Corinthians 11:23-26
- It’s a time of *personal reflection* – 1 Corinthians 11:27-29
- It’s a *lasting memorial of our hope* in Jesus – 1 Corinthians 11:26
